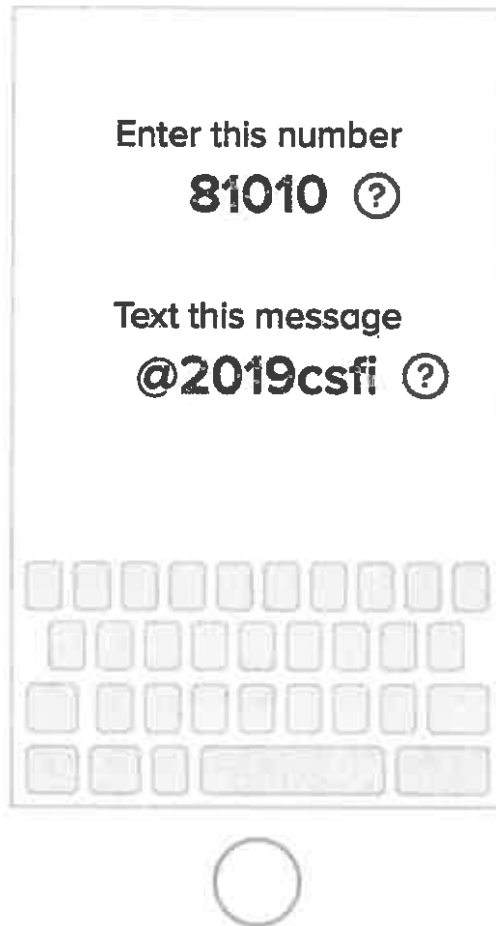

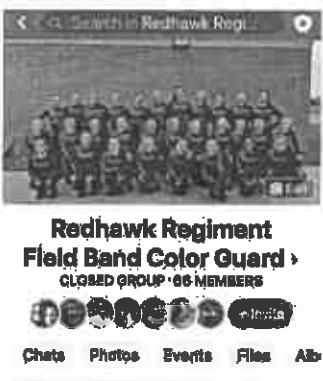

Central Square “Redhawk Regiment” Marching Band 2019 Season

Dear Parents, Current Members, Interested Friends and Future Members,

The Central Square “Field Band” recruitment is in full swing for the Fall 2019 season. Band students in grades 7-12 and Junior Varsity and Varsity Guard students enrolled in the Central Square Central Schools may participate in the field band program.

The “Field Band” program’s purpose and goal:

The Field Band is a program that allows students in our school system the opportunity to participate in a competitive marching activity. The Redhawk Regiment Marching Band will be competing in the New York State Field Band Conference (NYSFBC) “**Small School Division 1**”. This is the highest class in the small school division that includes all school districts under 4,000 students. The goal is to achieve individual and group excellence in performance. Striving to be the best musically and visually that we can and thrilling the listening audience are worthy goals for this season. With hard work and dedication we can meet the standards of excellence!! The Field Band along with the following feeder programs: Middle School Percussion Ensemble, High School Winter Drum Line, the Cadet Guard, JV Guard and the Varsity Guard have all had very successful seasons and are to be congratulated.

- The 2018 Redhawk Regiment Marching Band placed 4th out of 8 in their class at the Carrier Dome.
- The Middle School Percussion Ensemble continues to compete and earn first place in their class each year in their class at NYSPC Finals.
- The Cadet Guard had a great season of growth and we look forward to seeing the members continue on to JV and then Varsity Guard.
- The Junior Varsity Guard earned Silver medals at the Mid-York Color Guard Championships and had a great season of growth as well.
- The High School Winter Drum Line had a very successful season as they placed first at Victor in class competition and then followed that up by earning third place Bronze medals in their class at the NYSPC Finals Competition.
- The Varsity Winter Guard earned first place every week in Mid-York Circuit competition, first place in all three Regional competitions they attended, and placed first earning Gold medals in class competition at the Mid-York Color Guard Championships. This year’s Varsity Guard was the first Central Square Guard to earn a place in finals competition at WGI in Dayton Ohio and placed seventh out of 143 Guards in “A Class” competition.

Congratulations to the students and staff for their accomplishments and thank you to the parents who helped each week to provide the program needs. Central Square has a history of success and carries with it a tradition of excellence and pride that are traditions worth continuing.

Along with competing in the NYSFBC, the Redhawk Regiment Marching Band will be performing in several community Parades that are “community service” opportunities, as well as home varsity football games and the annual Homecoming events. The more that the Regiment performs the better the experience will be for everyone involved.

The Field Band Season Kick-off:

The program will kick off with a couple of rehearsals that will serve to introduce some of the music of the 2019 Field Band show, provide work on skills and also solidify numbers for the drill writer and music arrangers of this year's production.

Saturday, May 18th from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. – Pit and Battery Percussion only.

Rehearsal will take place at Paul V. Moore High School.

Saturday, June 15th from 10:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. there will be a full Field Band rehearsal held at the high school.

Thursday, July 25th from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. – Field Band Rookie Rehearsal (first year members)

Season Rehearsals:

On the calendar you will see the first summer Full Field Band rehearsal will be Monday, July 29th. We have tried to provide more time off for everyone in July before we begin the season rehearsals. Band Camp will be 7 days split over two weeks with a day off each of those two weeks.

Band Camp week is free of charge, but is priceless as far as its importance. Attendance is required, so that all students will be ready for the start of the competitive season.

Student Leadership Opportunities:

The one student leadership position that stands out to most students is that of Drum Major. While it is true that the Drum Majors are in direct leadership roles we also are able to offer other opportunities for up-coming juniors and seniors to have leadership roles during the season.

Community Preview Show and Performances:

This year's Community Preview Show will take in the stadium on Friday, August 9th at the end of Band Camp. The performance will be in the evening, so be sure to make plans to be in attendance for this Preview and final wrap up of Band Camp.

Throughout the competitive season in September and October the band will perform the production each weekend in competition. Please reference the attached calendar for all performance dates. The final New York State competition is the New York State Field Band Championships that are held in the Carrier Dome at Syracuse University on Sunday, October 27th, 2019.

End of Season Award's Celebration:

The season will conclude with our annual awards celebration in November. The date for the award's celebration is Sunday, November 3rd at 6:00 p.m. at Greenview Country Club.

Field Band Competition Trip:
“US Bands Marine Corps invitational” Competition
Navy Stadium - Annapolis, MD

Date: Thursday, September 26th (4:00 p.m.) through Saturday, September 28th, 2019 (return will be approx. 1:00 a.m. Sunday).

The annual competition trip is part of the 2019 Field Band season. We will need all students who have a performance spot in the Field Band to attend, since we will be competing in the USBand’s Event in MD on Saturday of the trip. We will rehearse and will be doing some educational events in the Baltimore / Philadelphia area as part of the trip that could include a show or concert, etc. Options are being looked into. The trip includes two nights in a hotel, coach transportation, professional show/concert, and a performance in competition. We will return late Saturday evening / Sunday morning to Central Square.

A detailed itinerary will be available shortly, but you can begin fundraising for the trip anytime. See the Music Booster parents so that they can help you get started with fund raising and there will also be other fundraising opportunities presented this evening and later on as they become available.

Calendar of times and commitments:

Please find a season calendar attached that will help you to be able to make plans. Understand that there may need to be a few alterations to the calendar; however, we will try to keep these alterations to a minimum. Changes will always be planned well in advance and will be communicated often.

How to join the “Regiment” Marching Band.

After reviewing this information and going over the calendar please return the sign up sheet to Mr. Haldeman or Mr. Woods in the high school by Friday, May 17th. In the Middle School return the sign up sheet to Mr. Graziano or Mrs. Ezzo by Friday, May 17th. You are also welcome to sign up this evening by returning the sheet at the end of the meeting.

Summer Practices:

Please see the calendar. All members are expected to be at all rehearsals with the exception of family vacations. The rehearsals will be designed to teach the music for the show and to emphasize marching technique, as well as to learn drill and body work.

It is our goal to accommodate as many students as possible that want to participate in the marching band program.

Details of times and places:

Once the competitive season begins a weekly information sheet with details of times and places will be handed out at practice as has been done in the past.

School “In Session” Practices:

Please see the calendar. Once school starts, be sure to check your calendars and plan for your rehearsals and other involvements. Communicate with your section directors and me about conflicts far ahead so that they can be worked out. We can only be as good as we practice! “One must practice like a champion to become a champion!” It is not easy to achieve excellence, but the rewards of working hard and performing the best show of your life is well worth the effort. Do everything you can to give yourself and your band the opportunity to succeed.

“Redhawk Regiment Marching Band” Performances:

Please see the calendar. Without exception!!! All performances are mandatory. We cannot have holes on the field when we go into competition either in state or out of state. The band will compete on a weekly basis at area high schools. The highlights of this competitive season are the performances at the New York State Field Band Conference Championship Show in the Carrier Dome at Syracuse University, as well as the performance in competition at US Band’s in the Navy Stadium in Annapolis, MD.

Since the Carrier Dome NY State Final’s event is at the end of the season each field band member will need to be ready and able to compete at the highest level of which they are capable.

Let the tradition continue:

We are looking forward to moving ahead on this year’s production. The show will be very entertaining for the audience to watch, as well as fun to perform. For all of those veteran members of the field band who still have memories of the Carrier Dome audience applauding them as they marched off the field last year: Bring your energy and enthusiasm to practice this year, so that this season’s production will be the best that it can be. The pride that is here in Central Square is outstanding. Lets keep it going with a successful season. With great numbers we can let everyone know about the pride we have here in Central Square. 2019 Field Band Season Budget

The 2019 Field Band season is budgeted at approximately \$35,000, which includes most of the program expenses, in addition to the exciting competition trip to the Navy Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, MD this fall.

This breaks down to \$425 per student for the season based on an 80-student band. This \$425 can be made as one payment or broken down into smaller payments. There will be opportunities to do **Individual fundraisers** (which are deposited directly into your child's Student Account) to reduce this cost for your family, including Gertude Hawk candy sales and working at Syracuse Mets baseball games (Vinny's Pizza stand in the stadium).

Additional Expenses may occur as the season progresses. The following items will be required to be purchased, if you do not already have them from a previous season:

Guard: Regiment T-shirt, Show T-shirt, Gloves, Shoes, Undergarments that work with this year's uniform, Makeup/ Hair Products, Banquet

Band: Regiment T-shirt, Show T-shirt, Dry Fit Shirt for under uniform, Shoes, Gloves (Brass and Winds), Banquet

*****Please note: the above additional expenses may be paid with money from your student account**

The Music Boosters intend to have a few group fundraisers, which go into the General Fund, to help offset some of these costs. Our annual Golf Tournament is June 9th at Greenview, so please start thinking about who you know that would like to donate a prize, sponsor a hole or have a team of golfers participate! Stay tuned for additional fundraising opportunities....and we welcome any ideas you may have to help us meet our financial goals.

We realize that families need some time to plan for these expenses. Please utilize our individual fundraisers throughout the year to pay for your season. Working at 10 Syracuse Mets baseball games would pay for the season!

The CS Music Boosters supports the entire Music Department in our district: not just Fieldband, Winter Guard and Drumline (high school and middle school), but also Parade Band (high school and middle school), the High School Musical, the Senior Scholarship Program, Summer Band Program and Elementary School music programs...with an operating budget of approximately \$32,000 - \$34,000 per year. Fundraisers for the General Fund are what keep this organization solvent and successful. Fortunately, both individual fundraisers (which go directly to your child's account) and general fundraisers (which go to the General Fund) are always available and can be extremely successful with all of our participation. If your child needs medical, dental, health, or hospital services, you as parent must give permission. It's the law.

What about times when you cannot be reached for permission? A child may be treated without parental consent when a physician determines a true emergency exists. That means the doctor determines the child needs immediate medical care and that an attempt to obtain parental consent would result in a delay which would increase the risk to the child's life or health.

Except in a true emergency, care may be ordinarily rendered to a child only with the consent of the parent or legal guardian. Sometimes a child may need unexpected care which is not, however, a true emergency. In such cases, making an effort to contact a parent for permission can delay treatment and create unnecessary anxious moments for the child.

You can prepare for unexpected care your children might need when you are away from home. To do this, make sure babysitters know how to reach you at all times. And when you know you will

be hard to reach, you can give permission to other adults. They can then act for you by permitting your child to be treated if unexpected care is needed.

This is a legal document. With it you may appoint relatives, friends, teachers, clergy, neighbors — anyone who is over 18 years of age — to be responsible for your children when you are away from them. It is especially important to prepare this form for the occasions when you know it will be hard to contact you.

Fill out this form carefully. Have your signature witnessed by an adult different from the person you are making responsible for your children.

After you complete this form, give it to the adult(s) you have named to act on your behalf. If your child needs unexpected medical treatment, the responsible adult(s) should present this document to the appropriate person — physician, dentist or hospital representative.
