Directions to Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, MD:

>From the NORTH:
Take I-97 SOUTH to US 50 EAST
EXIT US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (Exit #24) and bear to the right
Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right.
Turn Right onto Faragutt Road and proceed to Gate 2 for the parking lot entrance

>From WASHINGTON(WEST):
Take US 50 EAST
EXIT US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (Exit #24) and bear to the right
Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right.
Turn Right onto Faragutt Road and proceed to Gate 2 for the parking lot entrance

>From the SOUTH:
Take I-95 NORTH to I-495 EAST
Take I-495 EAST to US 50 EAST
EXIT US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (Exit #24) and bear to the right
Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right.
Turn Right onto Faragutt Road and proceed to Gate 2 for the parking lot entrance

>From the EAST:
Take US 50 WEST across the Bay Bridge
EXIT US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (SOUTH)
Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right.
Turn Right onto Faragutt Road and proceed to Gate 2 for the parking lot entrance

>The spectator lot is a PAY Lot - \$10 dollars for parking at the stadium

IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION

Arrival: Trucks and buses should enter Farragut Road. Only buses and trucks will be permitted through this gate.

Parking: Buses and trucks will park to the northeast of the stadium in the GOLD lot. Please follow signs and the directions of parking staff upon arrival. There is a \$10 parking fee for spectators charged by the stadium.

Restrooms: Restrooms are available in the stadium through Gate P.

Warm-up: The warm-up area is on the GOLD Side Parking Lot. The warm-up area will be roped off. Please DO NOT warm-up outside this area. Stay AWAY from the water tower area and the lawn of the courthouse. If you warm-up in this area your sound will travel directly into the stadium. Due to noise ordinances, please – no warm-up before 7 AM or after 9:30 PM. **NO PLAYING IS PERMITTED AFTER YOUR PERFORMANCE including drum cadences.** Please see the map for details.

Field surface: Artificial turf with permanent college hashes and taped high school hashes. Power will be available on the front sideline at the 50-yard line. Ensembles will enter and exit via the side 2 center.

Retreat/Awards: Drum major only retreat. Drum majors should report to the band entrance gate at the beginning of the last bands performance.

Commentary: Scores, recaps, and adjudicator commentary will be available via CompetitionSuite. Be sure to check your email for an activation link.

Concessions: Concessions will be provided inside of the stadium throughout the duration of the event. PepWear will be onsite selling event related merchandise and souvenirs.

Video Recording: Due to copyright laws, no audio or video recording is allowed at USBands sanctioned events.

BAND app: USBands is excited to partner with BAND in 2018 as our official communications application. Download the app and check your email for a link to join. BAND will be used to share recaps, event information, schedules changes, weather alerts, and much more.
