**Make arrangements to attend the practice and performance of the final regular season Home Game, as well as the Field Band competition on Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup>.**

**This is part of the Seasonal Performance Obligation of the Field Band.**

**Friday, October 11th**

**Band Room will stay open after school for middle school and high school students who must stay in town before the practice/game. Be sure to eat dinner prior to arriving!**

- 4:00** All Field Band members arrive at the high school band room. Brass, Woodwinds and Percussion change into uniform bibbers and have all uniform parts ready.
- 4:30** "Pep Band Tune" practice in the band room (in bibbers) for brass, woodwinds and battery percussion.
- 5:00** Winds – Visual rehearsal on Field 1 or Parking Lot. Pit members warm-up in parking lot and then change into uniform.
- 5:00** Percussion rehearsal then change into uniform
- 5:30** Winds finish getting into uniform.
- 6:10** Winds and Battery move to the stadium to reserved section with music stands for Pep Band.
- 6:25** Star Spangled Banner – Jessica Georges
- 6:30** Winds and Battery - Pep Tunes for the first half of the game! No eating until after half-time performance.

**6:30 Pit loads and moves to the stadium.**

**Guard moves to the stadium**

**7:30 – 7:45 ish Half Time Show – Field Band exhibition**

**Following the field band's half time performance:**

**Return to the band room and put away instruments and equipment. Be sure everything is in place and is ready for Saturday morning.**

**Make arrangements to be picked up by 9:30 p.m.**

**The band room will be closed and locked for security purposes once the band equipment and instruments are returned and all students left the band room.**

**New Hartford Show**

**Equipment Vehicles:**

8:30 a.m. Equipment Bus and Equipment Truck arrive at the high school.

9:45 – 10:00 a.m. Field Band Members arrive.

- All Drum Line battery cases and Sousaphone cases placed outside against the wall for loading prior to the start of rehearsal.
- Color Guard equipment bags will be loaded onto buses.
- Brass, Woodwinds, Pit and Battery: Be sure to have with you **black socks and your "clean" and "shiny" marching shoes**. Also have proper undergarments for wearing under the uniforms. Bring gloves, gauntlets, shako wrap and shako.
- Turn in notes if you are leaving after awards

9:30 a.m. – Pit - Load carts and move to stadium area location T.B.D.

10:15 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. – Rehearsal includes final run: Wear Excellence shirts for rehearsal.

1:30 p.m. – Equipment vehicles moved to the stadium to load.

2:00 p.m. - Load equipment and instruments / Lunch by Boosters / Change and load passenger buses. Uniform bags will go on passenger buses with a change of clothes along with filled shako (jackets, gauntlets, gloves and shako wrap)  
Guard will travel in uniform to New Hartford. Winds and percussion travel in bibs with marching shoes and black socks. Flutes, Clarinets, Alto Saxes and trumpets take instruments and cases onto passenger buses. Tenor Saxes, Trombones, Baritone and Mellophones put instrument and cases under the buses. Guard equipment will be loaded onto the passenger buses.

3:00 p.m. - Buses arrive at high school along with the equipment truck drivers.

3:30 p.m. - Equipment vehicles leave and begin unloading upon your arrival at New Hartford High School.

4:00 p.m. - Passenger buses leave P.V. Moore en route to New Hartford High School.

5:30 p.m. – Arrive at New Hartford High School – Site of the competition. Hand stamps, use rest rooms. **Move Pit to warm-up area 6 (see map of campus)**

5:45 p.m. - Move to warm-up area (winds with instruments and uniform jackets, gauntlets, shako wrap and gloves in the shako as usual.

- 5:50 p.m. Visual warm-up and basics in **warm-up area is 6** (no one else will be there)
- 6:55 p.m. Sectionals for warming up and tuning
- 7:15 p.m. Ensemble
- 7:30 p.m. Load Pit carts, Circle and Sing and set the entrance block
- 7:40 p.m. Move to Staging
- 7:52 p.m. Staging for competition
- 8:05 p.m. Perform in competition

**Following Performance:** Take care of your instruments and equipment and then change into street clothes in the changing facilities (gymnasium) quickly and return to the stadium to the stadium for awards.

**Hang uniform "neatly" in uniform bag.**

**Awards are at 8:56 p.m.** Drum Major along with the following seniors should report to the end zone staging area by 8:30 p.m. for Retreat and Awards: Rachael Stringer, Hannah Carpenter and Jennifer Gasser.

**9:15 p.m. - Students board buses to return to Central Square after awards:**

Take attendance and leave en route to P.V. Moore – 9:30 – 9:45 p.m.

Buses return to Central Square: 11:15 p.m. to unload

Student pick-up time after unloading – Make arrangements for 11:30 p.m. pick-up.

**Post Contest Meeting:** Usually held in the Bradley High School Library immediately following awards.

**Pre-Sale Tickets:** Turn over ticket money and unsold tickets upon arrival to our host. Pre-sale tickets are available from Music Boosters or Mr. Haldeman for \$7.00 presale. Tickets are \$9.00 at the gate the day of the competition.

**Parents are needed to help with equipment on Saturday loading and unloading.  
Parents are also needed to be in the stands cheering!!**

\* Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. and show begins at 7:00 p.m.

\* If your parents are picking you up at New Hartford H.S. after the show, I must have a note by Saturday. Students returning with a parent must make arrangements to be sure that their instrument and uniform is taken care of when the equipment bus and truck return.

\* Parents must pick up their child in the presence of a chaperone at the buses after Awards.
