Schedule for the up-coming Home Show:

The Teacher’s Parking lot will be blocked off on Saturday. Everyone please park cars in the Millard Hawk lot for the day on Saturday starting at 12:00 noon. Do not park in front of the cafeteria, or around either loading docks so that these areas can be used for a warm-up area.

* **Band Members and Parents:** Parents and field band members: We are asking each student to bring in one to two dozen baked good items to be used in our bake sale for the Home Show. Please label your items and package them to be sold for fifty cents. The baked goods will be used for the judge’s room, hospitality, drivers and the directors of visiting schools. Thank you for your help.

Saturday, October 19th, 2019 - For rehearsal:

- Dress for the weather, but wear your Excellence shirts for rehearsal.
Bring a change of clothes if the weather appears to be inclement.
- Bring black socks, your grey uniform dry fit shirt for under uniforms, black gloves, shiny black band shoes, gauntlets and shorts to wear under the uniforms.
- **BE SURE TO EAT BREAKFAST BEFORE YOU ARRIVE.**
- **Saturday Rehearsal Schedule:**

- 11:00 a.m. – Load and move pit equipment to the stadium area.
- 11:15 a.m. - All Field Band members arrive.
- 11:45 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. - Rehearsal including final run
- 2:00 p.m. – Meeting in the Cafeteria for all Show Help
- 3:30 p.m. – Music Boosters provide food in cafeteria for band members. Eat and change into uniform.
- 5:00 p.m. - Area F will be available - Stretch, and Basics begins
Warm-up and ensemble space (West Genesee is in next at 7:03)
- 6:00 p.m. – Warm-up and Tuning
- 6:20 p.m. – Ensemble
- 6:35 p.m. – Load carts, circle and sing
- 6:45 p.m. – Move to staging area
- 6:55 p.m. – Arrive at the gate for staging.
- 7:05 p.m. - Central Square performs in competition.

Following the performance at the stadium equipment and instruments must be returned to the high school. Change out of uniform and then enter the stadium in time for Retreat and Awards. Seniors remain in uniform. Along with Drum Major Claire Ames the following seniors are also invited for Retreat: Tyler Jessie and Michelle Bedworth. For Senior Recognition all seniors must be in full uniform and must be with their parents at the track entrance area organizing to enter the stadium at 8:05 p.m.

8:25 p.m. - Senior Recognition: Seniors and their parents must be lined up ready to come onto the track immediately following the West Genesee High School band performance. The seniors and parents will move onto the track toward the 50 yard line. Parents line up behind your son or daughter. When the field band member's name is called, the field band member please take two steps forward to be recognized.

Drum Major Retreat and Awards:

As soon as Senior Recognition has ended, Drum Majors and those involved in Retreat move to the end zone area to join the other Drum Majors waiting to march onto the field for Awards.

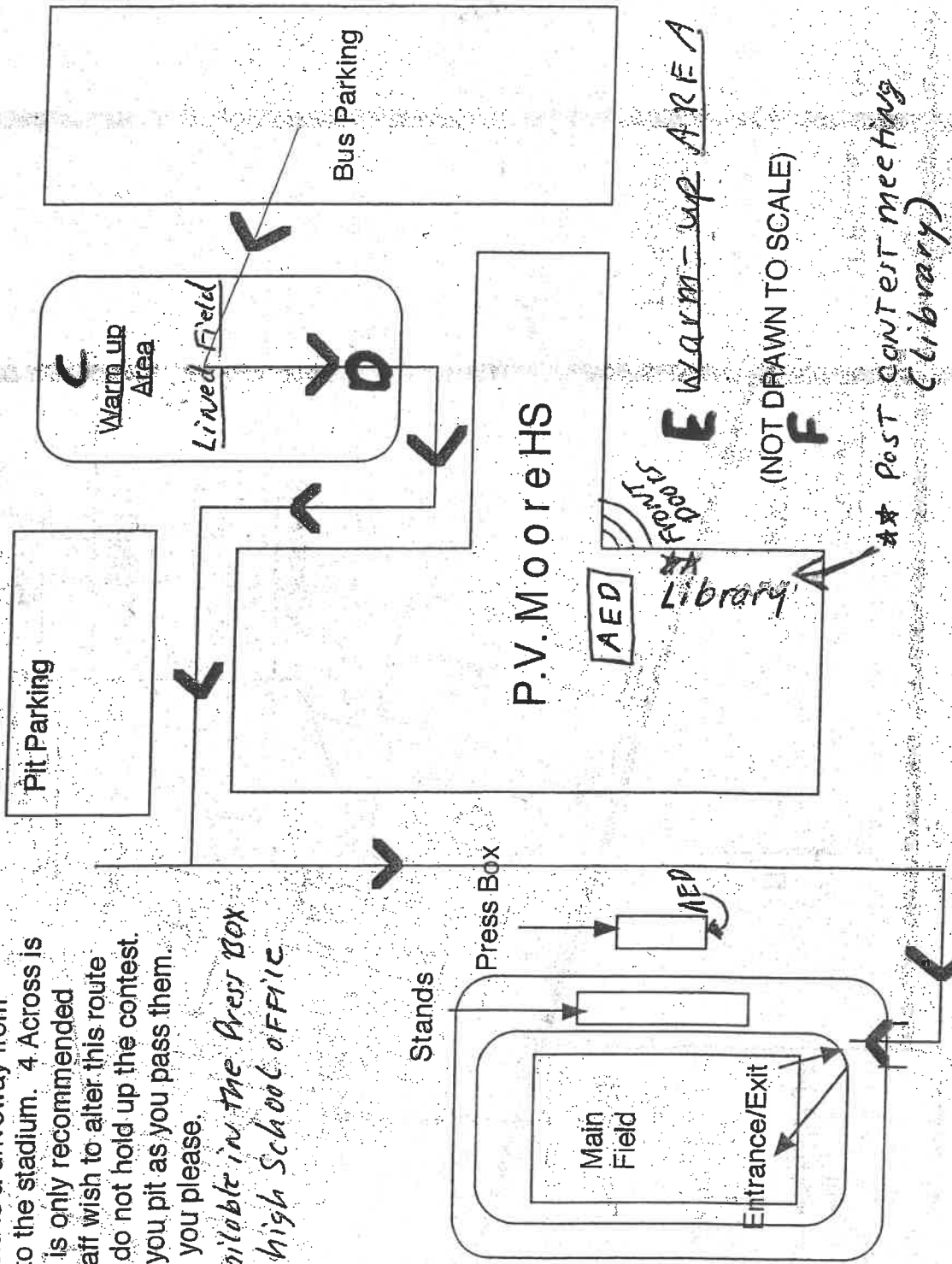

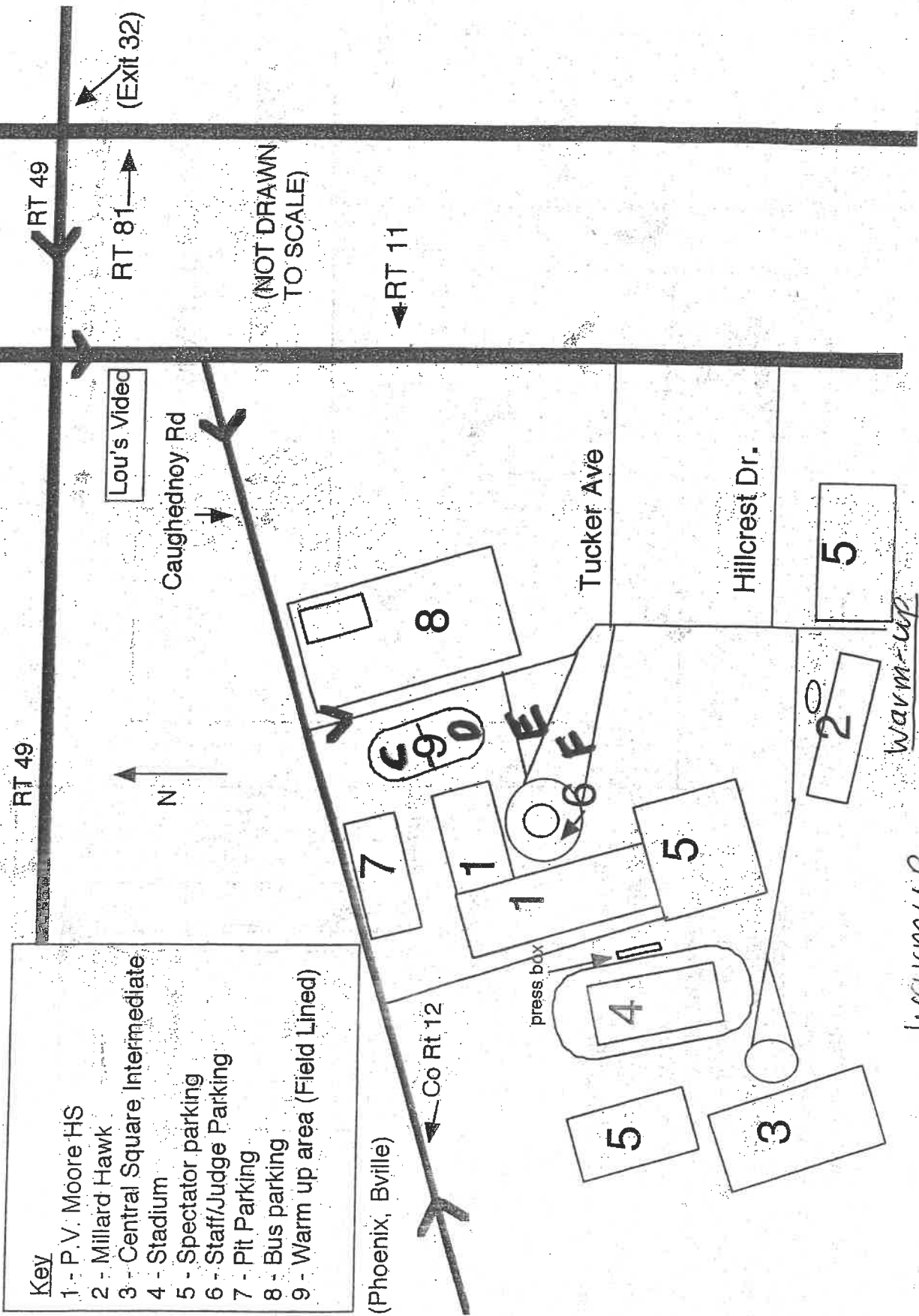
